 the following chattels to wit two yoke of oxen three years old one white
 & his mate a roan or speckled steer the other yoke is one a dark
 brindle and his mate is white and red & black a steer Murrant free of
 incumbrance and against any adverse claims upon condition
 that if I pay to said James M. Lee twenty Dollars in four
 Months from this date agreeable to my note of this date for that
 sum payable to said James M. Lee on demand this deed
 shall be void otherwise in full force and effect the parties agree
 that until condition broke said property may remain in possession
 of said Charles Tugua but after condition broken said James M.
 Lee may at his pleasure take and remove the same Witness our
 hands this 15th day of July AD 1858 Charles ^{his} Tugua
 in presence of J. B. McGinnis mark
