 the north west 1/4 of the north East Quarter being 10 acres in the South
 west Corner of said 36 acres in Sec no five (5) in Township no Seventy

 ten acres timber land more or less to have and to hold said premises above
 described unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns
 forever And the said Uriah B White will forever warrant and defend the
 title against all persons whomsoever and the said Mary White hereby relin-
 quishes all her right of power in and to the following described premises
