Know all men by these presents that whereas James Hornback  
and David Broderick of the same place the real Estate heretofore described and whereas the Deed  
of Conveyance then executed by us to the said David A. Broderick was never recorded  
and is alleged to have been lost now therefore in consideration of the sum of \$1000 &  
of the money then paid us therefore we the said James Hornback & Emily Hornback do  
hereby Convey to the said David A. Broderick the following described real estate situated  
in the County and State of Iowa to wit commencing at the North East corner  
of the west half of the east west Quarter of section numbered Six (6) in Township  
No. Seventy five North of Range No. Twenty seven (27) West 5 P.M. and running thence
