hundred Dollars in hand paid to hereby sell and convey unto Morgan
& Kordyke of Allis County and State of Iowa the following described
premises to wit The East half of Section No fifteen (15) and the South
East Quarter of the North West Quarter of Section No fifteen (15)
the South half of the South East Quarter of Section No ten (10) & the South
East of the South West Quarter of Section No ten (10) all in Township
No seventy seven (77) North of range No twenty six (26) West of the 5th P.M.
Iowa Containing four hundred and eighty acres (480) according to the
Original Survey and we do hereby Covenant with the said Morgan
& Kordyke that we are lawfully seized of said premises that they
are free from incumbrances that we have good right and lawful
authority to sell the same and we do hereby Covenant to warrant
and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons
whomsoever and the said Sarah Bell Cavenow hereby relinquishes all
her right of Dower in and to the above described premises as well as all
her in and to said land by virtue of the title therof being vested in her
