that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum
of three hundred and eighty dollars paid by the said party of the second
part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
sold conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain
sell convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part
heirs and assigns certain tract or parcel of land situated in the state of
Iowa and being the North West fourth of South West fourth of section
thirty three (33) in township twenty five and range 28, twenty eight
and the North East fourth of the South East fourth of section 32
thirty two in township twenty five North of range twenty eight (28)
West containing Eighty (80) acres in both lots be the same more or less
Together with all the and singular the hereditaments rights privileges
and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining to
have and to hold the said premises as above described with the appurten-
ances to the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever
and the said party of the first part for themselves and their heirs executors
and administrators as hereby covenant to and with the said party of the
second part his heirs executors administrators and assigns that they
are well seized of the premises above conveyed as of a good and
defeasable estate in fee simple and has also right to sell and con-
vey the same in manner and form as aforesaid that they are free from all
incumbrances and that the above bargained premises in the quiet
and peaceable possession of the said party of the second part his heirs or
assigns against the claims of all persons whomsoever will forever
warrant and defend in witness whereof the said parties of the first part
has hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above
written Signed sealed and delivered in presence of Joshua Daugherty
