 North half of the Northwest quarter of Section twenty one Township  
 Seventy four in range twenty eight containing, 819 1/4 acres to have  
 and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto him the said  
 Hiram Wright his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jacob Ruffner  
 for himself his heirs doth hereby covenant with the said Hiram Wright  
 his heirs and assigns that the premises before mentioned are free and clear  
 from all encumbrance whatsoever and that he will warrant and defend the  
 same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever in testimony where  
 of the said Jacob Ruffner and Eliza his wife have hereunto set their hands  
 and sealed this 14<sup>th</sup> day of November AD 1856 signed sealed and delivered  
 in presence of William Mansell
