I, David L Johnson, Know all men by these presents that we David L Johnson and Nancy, Johnson wife of said David L Johnson of the County of Highland and State of Ohio in consideration of the sum of Six hundred & forty dollars in hand paid by Daniel L Davis of the same place have bargained and sold and do hereby grant and convey unto the said David Davis his heirs and assigns forever the following premises situate in Madison County and State of Ohio in the district of land subject to entry at the Chariton district and described as follows to wit - North East quarter of South east quarter & East half of North east quarter of Section No thirty four (34) in Township No seventy four (74) North of Range No twenty seven (27) N containing one hundred and twenty acres also South east quarter of South east quarter of Section No twenty seven (27) in Township No (74) Seventy four North of range No twenty seven (27) N containing fifty acres to have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Daniel L Davis his heirs and assigns forever and the said David L Johnson for himself and heirs doth hereby covenant with David L Davis and his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seised of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrance whatsoever and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Daniel L Davis his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever in testimony whereof the said David L Johnson and Nancy Johnson have hereunto set their hands and seals this tenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven
