part. Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration
of the sum of Eighty Dollars to us in hand paid by of Rogers party
of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained sold and almed and by these presents do grant Bargain sell &
convey unto the said John F. Rogers his heirs & assigns forever the following
described property tract or parcel of land situate in the County of
Madison Iowa and known and described as follows to wit the South
West Quarter of the North East quarter of Section thirty three Town
ship No Seventy four north of Range No twenty eight West containing
forty acres also all the rights privileges and appurtenances thereto
belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the above
described & Bargained premises unto him the said Rogers his heirs and
assigns forever to we the said John L. Newton and Sarah A. Damak his
Wife do for our selves Covenant & agree with the said Rogers his heirs
& assigns that we are well seized of the above premises as of a good
and indefeasible Estate in fee simple that we have a good right
to sell the same & that they are free from all incumbrance whatever
and we do further agree for our selves and heirs executors & admis
tutors that we will forever warrant & defend the legal claims or
claims of all persons whatsoever given under our hands & seals this
29th Day of October AD 1856
