Know all men by these presents that we Emmer Bales and Mary A Bales wife of the said Emmer Bales of the County of Belmont State of Ohio in consideration of the sum of five hundred and sixty dollars in hand paid by Benjamin Griffith of the same place have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Benj Griffith his heirs and assigns forever the following premises situate in the County of Madison State of Iowa and in the first addition District being the East half of the southwest quarter of section the five Township Seventy seven Range 29 twenty nine containing 80 acres to have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Griffith his heirs and assigns forever and the said Emmer Bales for himself and heirs do hereby covenant with said Benjamin Griffith his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seised of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from all encumbrance whatsoever and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Griffith his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever in testimony whereof Emmer Bales and Mary A Bales have hereunto set their hands and seals this 8th day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight.
