Survivor and Morrow the said sum of twenty Eight dollars and Eighty Cents on or before the twentieth day of February AD 1860 according to the tenor and effect of a certain promissory note of even date herewith Executed by me to the said Kervista Ann Morrow for the said sum of twenty Eight Dollars and Eighty Cents payable with interest thereon at the rate of ten percent per annum on or before the said 20th day of February AD 1860 otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect in law as an absolute sale & conveyance of the personal property aforesaid in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 20th day of February 1859
