

1858 between Mahungary Hollingsworth of Madison County Iowa  
of the first part and William Hollingsworth of Washington County  
Iowa of the second part Witnesseth that the said party of the first  
part in Consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars to him paid  
hath sold and by these presents doth grant and convey unto the  
said party of the second part and his legal representatives the following  
described goods Chattles & property to wit One heifer three years old  
one yearling steer Six head of hogs two tons of hay two saales One block  
one Cultivator on wheels now in my possession at the County of Madison  
as aforesaid together with the appurtenance and all the estate title and interest  
of the said party of the first part there in this grant is intended as a security  
for the payment of fifty Dollars with interest on or before the expiration

of one year from the date hereof which payment if duly made will make  
this Conveyance void witness my hand this 4<sup>th</sup> Day of March 1858  
the State of Iowa)
