Lowe Governor of the State of Iowa in the name and by the authority of the people of said State do constitute him Notary Public within and for the County of Madison in the State of Iowa and do authorize empower and require him to execute and fulfill the duties of that Office according to law and to have and to hold the said office with all the rights authorities privileges and emoluments thereunto legally appertaining for the term of three years unless sooner removed by the governor in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and caused to be affixed the great Seal of the State of Iowa Done at Des Moines this twenty fourth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight of the independence of the United States the Eighty Third and of this State the Thirteenth by the Governor Ralph P. Lowe
