White of the same County of the second part Notary Public that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargain and sell and do by these presents bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns forever the tract of real Estate in the County of Madison State of Iowa to wit the East half of the North East quarter of Section No Twenty (20) in Township No Seventy seven (77) North of Range No 22 East Twenty Eight West of the fifth P.M. containing Eighty acres (80) by government survey to have and to hold the premises above described with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto her the said second party and to her heirs ^{and assigns} forever the said Lovell White hereby covenanting for his heirs executors and administrators that the above described premises are free from any incumbrance that they have full right to sell the same and he well warrants and defend the title unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the said Laura White wife of the said Lovell White hereby relinquishes all her right of dower in the foregoing described premises in witness whereof the said parties of the first part have hereunto set their hands the day and year first herein written Lovell White
