Joel Hayworth <sup>up</sup> know all men by these presents that we Joel Hayworth  
To D Dea and Mahala Haworth his wife of Madison County, State  
Milton Wilson of Iowa in consideration of the sum of four hundred  
Dollars in hand paid do hereby sell & convey unto Milton Wilson  
of Dallas County State of Iowa the following described premises to wit  
West half (½) of south West quarter of Section 10, twelve Township, Seventy  
seven (77) Range Twenty nine (29) and hereby covenant with the said Milton  
Wilson that we are lawfully seized of said premises that they are free  
from incumbrances that we have good right & lawful authority to sell  
the same and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said  
premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the  
said Mahala Haworth hereby relinquish all her right of Dower in and to  
the above described premises signed this Eighteenth day of September AD  
1858 in presence of George M Adams
