William T Smith of the City of Philadelphia
Aphra and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and Samuel
R Marshall of the same City of the other part witnesseth that
the said William T Smith and Elizabeth his wife for the consideration of the sum of fifteen Hundred Dollars lawful money of the
United States of America unto them well and truly paid by the
said Samuel R Marshall at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted
bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these
presents do grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm
unto the said Samuel R Marshall his heirs and assigns all those
the following described premises situate in the County of Madison and
State of Iowa being the South east quarter and the East half of
the South west quarter of Section sixteen Township Seventy four and
Range Twenty eight containing two hundred and forty acres be
the same more or less being the same premises which Jacob Berry
holmes and Ellen his wife by indenture dated the 2nd day of March
A D 1854 and intended forth with to be recorded conveys to the said William
T Smith in fee - Together with all and singular the improvements
Buildings ways waters watercourses Rights privileges Hereditaments and
Appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in anywise appertain
ing and the reversion and remainders rents issues and profits thereof
and all the estate right title interest property claims and demand whatsoever
of them the said William T Smith and Elizabeth his wife in law, squint
or otherwise howsoever, of, in, and to the same or every part thereof to have
and to hold the said hereditaments and premises hereby granted as
mentioned and intended so to be with the appurtenances unto the said
Samuel R Marshall heirs and assigns to and for the only proper use
and behoof of the said Samuel R Marshall his heirs and assigns forever
and the said William T Smith for himself and the said Elizabeth his
wife their heirs all and singular the hereditaments and premises
herein above described and granted as mentioned and intended so
to be with the appurtenances unto the said Samuel R Marshall his heirs
and assigns against them the said William T Smith and Elizabeth
his wife their heirs and against all and every other person or persons whom
soever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof shall
and will warrant and forever defend in witness whereof the said
parties to these presents have hereunto interchangeably set their hands

her power in the same therein described freely and without any compulsion from or influence
