South west quarter of the South East quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section no
twenty-five (25) and the north west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the North East
quarter of Section No twenty-six thirty six (36) in township No
Seventy six North of Range number twenty nine (29) West of
5th P.M. and we do hereby covenant with the said Joseph
Hutchings that we are lawfully seized of said premises that
they are free from encumbrance that we have good right
and lawfull authority to sell the same and we do hereby
covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against
the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the said
Susan E Turner hereby relinquishes all her right of dower
in and to the above described premises signed this 26th
day of February A.D 1857
