of Ohio do give grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said Charles French  
the following described tract or lot of Land situate in Madison County and State  
of Iowa and a described as follows to wit the north East quarter of section nineteen  
(19) Township seventy five (75), Range Twenty Eight (28) containing one hundred and  
sixty acres (60) of land be the same more or less but subject to all legal high  
ways to have and to hold the above granted and bargained premises with the appur-  
tenances thereto belonging unto him the said French his heirs and assigns  
forever to his and their own proper use and behoof and we the said John  
& Anna Harriet R Putnam do for ourselves our heirs executors and administrators  
covenant with the said French his heirs and assigns that at and until the  
enrolling of these presents we are well seized of the premises as a good  
and indefeasible estate in fee simple and have good right to bargain and  
sell the same in manner and form as above written and that the same be free  
from all encumbrance whatsoever and furthermore we the said John & Anna  
Harriet R Putnam do by these presents bind ourselves our heirs forever to  
warrant and defend the above granted and bargained premises to him  
the said French his heirs and assigns against all lawful claims and demands  
and whatsoever and to the said Harriet R Putnam do hereby release  
and forever quit claim unto the said French his heirs and assigns  
all my right and title of owner in the above described premises in writing  
whereof we have hereunto set our hands and sealed the fourth day of  
November in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and fifty eight
