hereby acknowledged has granted and sold and by these presents grant
bargain sell and convey and confirm unto the said party of the second
part his heirs and assigns forever the certain tract or parcel of real estate
situate in the County of Madison State of Iowa to wit the north east
quarter of the North east quarter of section (18) Eighteen and the west
half of the North West quarter of section Seventeen (17) in township
seventy four (T4) North of range twenty eight West containing one
hundred and twenty (120) acres in the district of lands subject to sale at
Chariton Iowa to have and to hold the premises above described with
all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said second

that the above described premises are free from any encumbrances
