I know all men by these presents that J of H Evans  
Sheriff of the County of Madison and State of Iowa  
on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1857 under and by an writ  
of Execution issued out of the district court of said

County on a certain judgement against Thomas Bera and Co and in  
favor of Stadler Brothers & Co for the sum of one thousand and thirteen  
Dollars and five cents principal interest and cost such and to the Sheriff of  
said County directed after given due and legal notice of the sale of  
said property hereafter describe the same having been bade upon by me  
There sold at public auction at the door of the office of the Clerk in

the city of Winterset the County Seat of Madison County to the said  
Stadler Brothers and as the following described real estate to wit  
the East third of Lot No Eight in Block Eleven in Original Town  
Plot of Winterset Madison County Iowa for the sum of seven hundred  
and six dollars being the highest and best bid and that being  
the highest and best bid offered for the same and now unless re-  
demption is made of said real estate within one year from the date  
hereof and that said Sale according to law said Stadler Brothers  
& C or his heirs or assigns will be entitled to a deed for the same  
In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand as Sheriff  
of said County as aforesaid the day and year aforesaid

Whereof on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1856 Stadler Brothers & Co filed  
their petition in the district court of the County of Madison and  
State of Iowa against Thomas Bera & Co and whereas at the  
June term 1854 of said district Court in and for said County  
such proceedings were had that judgement was rendered against  
said Thomas Bera & Co for the sum of one thousand and thirteen  
Dollars and five cents principal and interest and whereas on  
the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 1857 the said Stadler Brothers & Co caused  
an execution to issue out of the office of the Clerk of said court  
on said judgement and delivered to Joseph H Evans as Sheriff  
of said County and whereas on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1857  
the said Sheriff after given due and legal notice for more than  
four consecutive weeks struck off and sold the same at public auc-  
tion to the said Stadler Brothers and for the sum of Seven hundred  
and six dollars being the highest and best bidder therefor and whereas the time  
of redemption being one year from the 4<sup>th</sup> day of December 1857 has  
now expired the said Thomas Bera and Co having failed to redeem the  
same I Joseph H Evans in consideration of the premises and by virtue  
of the power in me vested as such Sheriff do hereby bargain and sell  
said property unto the said Stadler Brothers & Co and to their heirs and  
assigns forever and as such Sheriff warrant and defend the same  
against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and herein  
unto attach certificate of sale in Winterset whereof I have hereunto
