D Lowell White To D Deed This deed of bargain and sale made and executed the seventeenth day of September AD Eighteen hundred and fifty Eight by & Wilson T Smith between Lowell White & Laura White his wife of the County of Polk in the State of Iowa of the first part and Wilson T Smith of the second

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part witnesseth that the said party of the first part in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever the tract of real Estate in the County of Madison State of Iowa to wit the South East quarter of the North west quarter of Section No twenty two (22) Township No seventy seven (77) North of Range twenty eight (28) N containing forty acres tax title and presumption Excepted in the warrantee of this deed To have and to hold the premises above described with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said second party and to his heirs & assigns forever the said Lowell White & Laura White his wife hereby covenants for their heirs executors administrators that the above described premises are free from any encumbrances that they have full right to sell the same & they will warrant & defend the title unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns against the lawful claim of all persons whomsoever & the said Laura White the wife of the said Lowell White hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in the foregoing described premises In witness whereof the said party of the first part have hereunto set their hands the day & year first herein written
