I know all men by these presents that we Bonham Kester and Priscilla Kester husband of Madison County, Iowa in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto David Wilson of Madison County, Iowa the following described real property to wit Situate in Madison County, Iowa to wit Commencing at the North East corner of the East half of the South west quarter of Section thirty six (36) in Township No Seventy Six Range No Twenty Eight (28) N 5 R 16 E Iowa containing two (2) acres of land and run from said corner South Seventeen Rods and Six tenths $17\frac{6}{10}$ thence West four (4) Chances and fifty four and three fourths $54\frac{3}{4}$ South Seventeen Rods and Six tenths $17\frac{6}{10}$ thence East four Chances and fifty four & three fourths links $54\frac{3}{4}$ to the place of beginning, and we warrant and defend the same against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever given under our hands and this twenty seventh day of April the year 1858
