To all to whom these presents shall come greeting
Whereas Edmund Scherker of Madison County Iowa
has deposited in the office of the register of the State of Iowa Land office
of the State of Iowa a certificate of the school fund commissioner of
of Madison County Iowa whereby it appears that full payment has
been made by the said Edmund Scherker according to the provisions
of the act of the general assembly of the 25th of February 1857
Entitled an act to provide for the management and disposition
of the school fund for the west half of the North west quarter

of section nine township seventy four (74) North Range twenty nine 29 West of 5th Principal Meridian containing Eighty (80) acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said lands returned to the general Land office of the United States by the surveyor general which said tract has been purchased by the said Edmund J. Meeker Now know ye that the State of Iowa in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of the general assembly in such case made and provided have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Edmund J. Meeker and to his heirs and assigns the said tract of land above described to have and to hold the same together with all the rights privileges immunities and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging unto the said Edmund J. Meeker and to his heirs and assigns forever in testimony whereof I Ralph P. Lowe governor of the State of Iowa have caused these letters to be made patent and the great seal of the State of Iowa to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at Des Moines the seventh Day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight and of the State of Iowa the twenty (20) By the governor
