for himself and heirs do hereby covenant with said William L Pyle
his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid
that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrance whatso
ever and that he will forever warrant and defend the same unto the
appurtenances unto the said William L Pyle his heirs against the
lawful claims of all persons whomsoever in witness whereof the said
