Smith his heirs and assigns that his lawfully devised of the premises aforesaid and that they are free and clear from all encumbrances whatsoever and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Wm. Smith his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever On witness whereof the said Jacob Cherryholmes and Ellen Cherryholmes his wife have hereunto set their hands and seals this 5th day of March A.D. 1857
