The united States of America to all to whom these presents shall come greeting whereas in pursuance of the act of congress approved September 28th 1850 entitled an act granting Bounty Land to certain officers and soldiers who have been engaged in the military service of the united States Warrent No 4869 for 160 acres issued in favor of Isaac Finkbone Private, Captain Sanderson's Company Second Regiment Ohio volunteers War of 1812 has been returned to the general Land office with evidence that the same has been duly located upon the South East quarter of Section fourteen in Township seventy seven North of Range Twenty nine West in the District of Lands subject to sale at fort Des Moines Iowa containing one hundred and sixty acres according to the official plat of the survey of the said land returned to the general land office by the surveyor general which has been assigned to Thomas H Workman & William H Daily Now know ye that there is therefore granted by the united States unto the said Thomas H Workman and William H Daily the tract of Land above Described to have and to hold the said Tract of Land with the appurtenances thereof unto the said Thomas H Workman and William H Daily and to their heirs and assigns forever in Testimony whereof I Franklin Pierce President of the united States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the general Land Office to be hereunto affixed given under my hand at the city of Washington the fifth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and fifty five and of the Independence of the united States the seventy ninth by the President
