do hereby sell to John Shuthers of the County of Madison and
State of Iowa in consideration of the sum of
Three hundred and Fifty dollars in hand paid by John
Shuthers of the County and State aforesaid have bargained and
Sold and do hereby bargain sell and convey to the said John
Shuthers the following described personal property to-wit
one yoke of Oxen both six years old in the Spring of 1859
both of a red color one having a drooping horn the other a
crumple horn also another yoke of Oxen both six years old
in the Spring of 1859 one being a spotted steer white and
red skin the other being a red steer with one horn of
a rough appearance also one other yoke of oxen both
seven years old in the Spring of 1859 one of a dark red color
having the point of one horn broken off the other
being a liver backed ox with speckled sides with one
horn a little broken and also one heavy ox wagon with
wooden spindles wide tracked and of this make I
witness whereof I hereunto set my hand this 1st day of
November A D 1858
