of Two hundred and Eighty Seven dollars to me paid by John C Johnston of the county & State aforesaid do sell and convey to said John C Johnston the following goods and chattels to wit One Bay Mare 6 years old one Bay Horse 7 years old one Two horse Wagon on the narrow track one set of Two horse harness one Bell Metal Click Twenty one heads of Hogs Two Spotted Steer calves one year old each next spring and one hundred bushels of Corn Warranted free of any incumbrance and against any older claims and I have put the said John C Johnston in possession of said property by delivering to him this deed in the name of the whole

The above Mortgage to be void on the payment of a certain promissory note of even date herewith for two hundred & Eighty Seven dollars payable one year after date executed by said P. Cleor and payable to said John C Johnston
