West 15 chains North 6 ⁷⁷/₁₀₀ chains East 15 chains North 14 ²⁵/₁₀₀ chains
to place of begining said plot is divided into blocks each
block is four chains east and west and four chains and
fifteen links North and South except the south tier which
is four chains and two links North and South each block
has an alley running through it east and West which is
16 and $\frac{1}{2}$ feet wide the blocks are numbered from the North
West corner east and west alternately as shown on the
plat here to anset the lots are all sixty six feet east and
West and one hundred and twenty eight feet and nine inches
North and South except the south tier of lots in the south
tier of blocks which is one hundred and twenty feet and
four inches North and South the lots are numbered from north
east corner west and east alternately as shown on the plot
the streets are all sixty six feet wide except Barnard street.

which is 33 feet and south street which is 33 feet wide east of the south east corner of block 17 the streets are named as follows begining at west side first West str. Monroe str. Pike str. Davis str. Chestnut str. Webster str. Summit str. Grade str. all of which run North and south begining at North side first Bernard str. Clay str. Washington str.  seventy five North (75) of range twenty nine (29) west to me personally
 known to be the identical persons they represent themselves to be
 and acknowledge the disposition of said lands as shown in and
 by said map & field notes subdivided laid out & surveyed
 unto streets and Alleys Blocks and town lots was of their
 free and voluntary consent and in accordance with their desire
 and the said Jane Davis acknowledged that she freely and
 voluntarily relinquished all right of Dower in and to so much
 of said lands as is and by said map and field notes appropriated
 to Streets and Alleys Given under my hand this 26th
 day of February 1859 Fred G. Mason Justice of the Peace *(Seal)*
 filed February 26th A.D. 1859 at 5. O'clock P.M. David Bissell
