 *205 hundred & fifty in hand paid do hereby sell and
 convey unto Wendelin Michle of Polk County and State of Iowa the
 following described premises to wit the South west quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of the
 North West quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) of Section No Eleven (11) in Township No Seventy
 Seven (77) North of range No Twenty Seven containing forty acres and
 we do hereby covenant with the said Wendelin Michle that we are
 lawfully seized of said premises that they are free from encumbrance
 that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same and
 we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises
 against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever and the said
 Josephine Dippert hereby relinquishes all her right of Dower in and
 to the above described premises signed this 25th day of June A.D. 1857
