the condition of the above mortgage is such that whereas said
Hindman has this day executed his promissory note to said
John Hindman of even date herewith for the sum of two hundred
Dollars payable one year after date with ten per cent inter-
est Now if the said William Hindman Jr shall pay or cause
to be paid said note when due then the said William Hind-
man is to have said mortgaged property and keep possession of
the same but if not fully paid when due then the said
John Hindman is to have said mortgaged property as his own
and is to take possession of them forthwith without any process
of law by force or closure Witness my hand this 14th day
