one note on William Lowly for sixty four Dollars & one
note on Joseph Kelly for seventy eight Dollars each of said
notes is worth the amount which each one calls for and
that I Mary Brower as the wife of said William L Brower
we have a claim for the sum of six hundred and seventy
dollars being the amount in value of the aforesaid
property out of the estate of my said husband Wm L
