For the consideration of one hundred dollars I have this day sold unto of A Smith the ~~small~~ house used by me as a barber shop situate on Lot six in block Eleven in the town of Winterset Madison County Iowa also one barber chair six arm chairs and one common sofa all in said shop and this instrument to be void on condition that the undersigned will pay said Smith a promissory note calling for said sum of One hundred dollars in six months from the 9th day of March 1859 with the interest due thereon otherwise in full force in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 15th day of March 1859
