and assigns all my interest in all corn now growing on my farm
in center Township County and State aforesaid described as
follows to wit in Section one in Township Seventy five Range
twenty eight to have and to hold the same forever and I
the said party of the first part will forever warrant and defend
my said interest against all persons whomsoever upon condition
however that if the said party of the first part shall well and
truly pay to the said party of the second part his heirs and
assigns a certain promissory note given to the said party

of the second part bearing date of June 24th 1859 calling for the sum of fifty eight dollars and sixty eight cents due three months after date according to the tenor thereof then these presents to be void otherwise in full force in law In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand this the 27th day of June AD 1859
