Iowa in consideration of the sum of thirty eight hundred
dollars in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do
 hereby sell & convey unto George Blafel of Madison Co State of Iowa the
 following described Land & premises to wit the south West quarter of section
 No 27 with the exception of two acres sold & deeded to Lehall on which
 their mill stands said two acres being fully described in their deed
 also the west half of the south East quarter of section twenty seven
 (27) also the undivided half of the North west quarter of the south
 west quarter of section thirty five (35) also the North west quarter
 of the south East quarter and ten acre or the North East of south
 West quarter of the south East quarter of section thirty four (34)
 all the above Described Land being & lying in Township Seventy
 Six (76) North of Range No Twenty six (26) West of fifth (5) P.M.
 Iowa containing three hundred & Twenty acres more or less
 and we do hereby warrant & defend the title against all
 lawful claims whatsoever signed this the 17 day of December
 A.D. 1857
