Isaac Mills This indenture witness that Isaac Mills & Julia T., his wife of Marion County in the State of Dayton Mills Indiana in consideration of Thirteen hundred Twenty five Dollars to them paid by Dayton Mills the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby bargain sell and convey to the said Dayton Mills his of Marion County in state of Indiana heirs and assigns forever the following Real Estate in Madison County and State of Iowa and described as follows to wit The North west quarter of section No Thirty four (34) Township No. seventy six (76) Range No Twenty nine (29) 5th P.M. of Madison County Iowa containing One hundred and sixty acres according to the original survey together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the same belonging to horses and to hold the same to the said Dayton Mills his heirs and assigns forever the grantors their heirs and assigns hereby covenanting with the grantees his heirs and assigns that the title so conveyed is clear free and unencumbered that they are lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid as of a true perfect and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple and that they will warrant and defend the same against all claims whatsoever.
