 David O'Brien in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and
Twenty Dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto David
O'Brien of Union County and State of Illinois the following described

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premises, to wit: The East half of the South East quarter of section Number Twenty six (26) in Township seventy seven (77) North of Range Number Twenty six (26) west containing eighty acres more or less according to the original Survey.

And I do hereby covenant with the said David C. Bishop - That I am lawfully seized of said premises; that they are free from incumbrances; that I have a good right and lawful authority to sell the same; and I do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whomever.
