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Filed February 28th 1859 at 9 o'clock at the David Bishop Recorder

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X John W. Marrs for the Consideration of the sum of one hundred
and fifty dollars (\$150.00) we John W. Marrs
Alonzo S. Guthrie and Elizabeth Marrs of the County of Union
and State of Iowa hereby convey to Alonzo S. Guthrie of the
County of Madison and State aforesaid the following tract of
land situated in the County of Madison and State of Iowa viz
(15) fifteen acres being a part of the north west quarter of the
South East fourth of section number (21) twenty one Township
(74) seventy four rods north of Range (27) twenty seven rods bounded
as follows beginning at the center of said section number (21)
Twenty one Rods East (30) Thirty rods Thence south (80) eighty
rods Thence west (30) Thirty rods Thence north (80) eighty rods
to the place of begining and we warrant the title against
the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever
etc. Witness our hands the 12th day of January A.D. 1859
