M. Fisher of said county & State the receipt whereof is here-
by acknowledged do hereby bargain sell and convey to the said
Martha M. her heirs and assigns forever the following Real
Estate viz The north half of the South West Quarter of
Section no Thirty four (34) and the north East Quarter of
the South East Quarter of Section no Thirty three (33) in Township
no seventy seven (77) north of Range no Twenty seven (27)

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west of the fifth Principal Meridian in the State of Iowa
Madison County. containing One hundred & twenty acres
according to government survey together with all the privileges
and appurtenances to the same belonging To have and to hold
the same to the said Martha M. Fisher her heirs and assigns
forever and the said Wm. B. Martha Bell Vanolock for ourselves
and our heirs do hereby covenant with said Martha M. Fisher
her heirs and assigns that they are lawfully seized of the premises
aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from all incumbrances
whosoever and that they will forever warrant and defend the same
with the appurtenances, unto the said Martha M. Fisher her
heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whom
