Know all men by these presents that we Jesse Goodrich and Jane Goodrich of Madison County Iowa in

consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars in hand paid do hereby sell and convey unto the Township District of Crawford Madison County and State of Iowa the following described premises to wit One Acre in the North West corner of the South East fourth of the North West fourth of Section Twenty Three Township Seventy Six Range Twenty Six and bounded as follows commencing at the aforesaid North West corner and then running South Twenty rods thence East Eight rods thence North Twenty rods thence West Eight rods to the place of beginning and we do hereby Covenant to Warrant and defend the said premises against the lawful claims of all persons whom-

soever unto the said Township District of Crawford for a School House Site so long as said Site shall be wanted or used for that purpose it being expressly stipulated and agreed between the said Grantors and Grantee. in consideration of the premises aforesaid that the said Grantee shall have the power to sell and convey the said premises and that the foregoing Sale and Conveyance shall be void and the said premises shall revert back to the said Grantors whenever the said Grantee shall cease to use the same for School house purposes.
