 feet thence East to the place of beginning, all in Block Number
 thirty two (32) and we warrant the title to the same a-
 gainst the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever save
 and except the claim of the School Fund of Madison
 County which appears on Record in said County
 in Book B 10 Page One Hundred against which
 we do not warrant. The said John Brewer in con-
 sideration of these presents agreeing to satisfy and pay
 in full said claim of said School fund

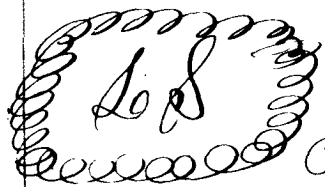
