 part. Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part for and
 in consideration of three hundred Dollars, cash in hand
 paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have given
 bargained, granted, and sold and by these presents doth
 give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party
 of the second part all their right title and interest in and unto
 a certain piece or parcel of land lying and being in the County
 of Madison and State of Iowa, known as designated as follows,
 viz. The South East quarter of the South West quarter of
 Section Twenty One in Township (75) Seventy five Range
 Twenty nine 29, West containing forty Acres,

To have and to hold the above described piece of property
 with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said
 party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns
 forever, and the said parties of the first do hereby covenant
 and agree to and with the said party of the second part
 that they will and that their heirs & Executors shall for-
 ever Warrant secure & defend the title of said premises
 from the claim or claims of every person claiming the same

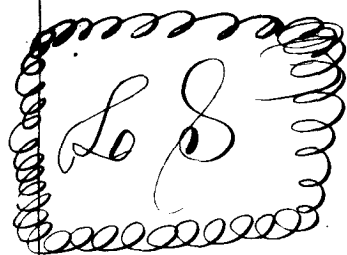
