April 1859 Jonas Conkling  
filed his petition in the  
District Court of Madison

County and State of Iowa against Luther De Borty for the  
foreclosure of a Mortgage on the following real estate to wit  
the South West qr. 14 of the North East qr. 14 of Section No. 20  
Also the South West qr. 14 of the North West qr. 14 of Sec No. 1  
all in Township No. Seventy five 75. and Range Seventy  
Seven, W. 5. P.M. Iowa in the County of Madison and at the  
October term term of said court to wit. On the 6<sup>th</sup> day  
of October 1859 such proceedings were had upon said pe-  
tition that said Jonas Conkling obtained a Judgement  
against said Borty for the sum of Thirteen

hundred and thirty dollars and four cents (\$130.04) and costs of print taxed at nineteen dollars and eighty cents and a decree of foreclosure with an order that a special execution issue for the sale of said mortgaged premises, and whereas on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of Jan'y. 1860. a special execution issued to the sheriff of said County commanding him, that he cause to be made of said Real Estate the sum of fifteen hundred and thirty dollars & four cents and nineteen dollars & eighty cents and further costs one dollar and twenty five cents. and upon the 23<sup>d</sup> day of July 1860. said Sheriff after having given public notice for four consecutive weeks in the Wisconsin-Madisonian a Newspaper published in said County; and by posting three notices, partly written and partly painted for said length of time one of which was on the door of the building in which the last District Court was held, and one in the Township in which said Real Estate is located, at the door of the Office of the Clerk of said Court, between the hours of 9. o'clock A.M. and 4. o'clock P.M. of said day, sold said Real Estate at public Auction to Jonas Beckling for the sum of Sixteen hundred and four Dollars and eighty nine cents, he being the highest and best bidder therefor. Therefore I Samuel Hamilton in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the powers in me vested by law do hereby sell and convey said premises to said Jonas Beckling
