\*175 These presents shall come greeting whereas Arnold  
Wheeler of Harrison County Ohio has deposited in the general land  
office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land office  
at Chanton whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the  
said Arnold Wheeler according to the provisions of the act of Congress of  
the 24<sup>th</sup> of April 1820 entitled an act making further provision for the  
sale of the public lands for the South East quarter and the North East  
quarter of the North East quarter of section two and East half of the  
North East quarter and the South West quarter of the North East  
quarter of section ten in Township seventy four north of Range  
twenty six west in the district of lands subject to sale at Chanton  
Towa, containing Three Hundred and thirty one acres and thirty  
seven hundredths of an acre according to the official Plat of  
the survey of said lands returned to the General Land Office  
by the surveyor-general which said tract has been purchased by  
by the said Arnold Wheeler Know ye that the United States  
of America in consideration of the premises and in conformity  
with the several Acts of Congress in such such cases made  
and provided Have given Granted and by these presents do  
Given and Grant unto the said Arnold Wheeler and to his  
heirs the said tract above described to have and to hold the  
same together with all the rights privileges immunities  
and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereto belonging

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unto the said Arnold Wheeler and his heirs and assigns forever
