W. McKnight of the County and state aforesaid; the re-
ceipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bar-
gained and sold and by these presents do grant
bargain & sell unto the said W. W. McKnight the
following described personal property or Chattels -
to wit, Seven Yoke of Oxen, One Yoke of a red color
to wit One entirely red the other red with a white face
six or seven years of age. The second Yoke one also
red to wit, One red the other red with a white face
both six years old, the third Yoke an stag spotted
and eight or nine years old, the fourth Yoke one
red to wit One a pale red with a lopped horn the
other a deep red both six years old, the fifth
Yoke one ten or twelve years old One a black
spotted Ox the other white spotted, the sixth
Yoke five years of age One a spotted stag
the other whitish. Ox. The seventh Yoke con-
sist of one Bull three years old and one two year
old steer, and also nine young Cattle which
will be two years old next spring and also nine
Calves both of these last mentioned kinds of stock
being now on my farm in Ohio Township Mad-
ison County Iowa. And also one stable Colt four
four years old next spring of a deep bay color
and also two bay Colts three years old next spring
and also one Colt of Iron Gray color two years
old next spring and also one other Colt of
a Gray color one year old next spring and
also Seven horses one of a yellow color lean
backed eight or nine years old, the second of
a red color seven years old, the third of a
dun color small size six years old, the
fourth of a brown color six years old the
fifth of a red color large size and

Johnston shall and will and truly pay said promissory note at maturity according to the tenor and effect thereof then the foregoing Sale to be null and void otherwise to be & remain in full force and effect in Double Intestimony Whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 2nd day of February A.D. 1860
