and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said
party of the second part, her executors and assigns, Two
hundred bushels of Corn, Seventy five Bushels of wheat
and fifteen bushels of Oats belonging to me in my
granary in the Town of Winterset Iowa, and now
in my possession at the place last aforesaid, and I do
hereby Covenant with the said party of the second part
her executors and assigns to Warrant and defend
the sale of the said property hereby made to the said
party of the second part, her executors and assigns
and against all and every person and persons
whomsoever.
