gained sold and do hereby sell and convey to said W. W. McKnight
The following personal property to wit. One ~~Red~~ Cow One
White Cow one two year old heifer. Six Yearling Calves One
Bay Horse with a white stripe in the face. One Sorrel
Mare ten head of hogs Six hundred bushels of Corn in
the Crib and one two horse wagon Loaded also up
and there presents are upon this condition that whenever I
have this day executed my promissory note to secure
W. W. McKnight of Even date herewith for Eighty one
Dollars and ninety seven cents payable six months after
date with ten per cent interest. Now if I shall well and truly
pay said promissory note at maturity. then the foregoing sale
to be null and void. otherwise to be in full force

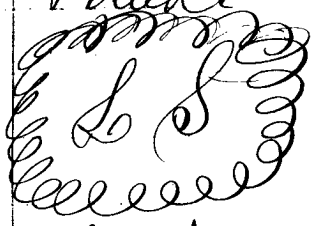
