Sell and convey unto Isaac Stewart of Madison County and
State of Iowa the following described premises town commencing
Eighty nine "89" rods south of the North west corner of the East
half of the North east quarter $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section one "1" Township
Twenty five "45" Range Twenty eight "28" thence East Twenty rods "20"
thence South thirty rods "30" thence west Twenty rods "20" thence
North thirty rods "30" to the place of beginning. And we do hereby
covenant with the said Isaac Stewart that we are lawfully seized
in fee simple of said premises that they are free from incumbrance
that we have good right and lawful authority to sell the same
and we do hereby covenant to warrant and defend the said
premises and appurtenances thereto belonging against the
lawful claims of all persons whatsoever and the said Eliza
Bevington hereby relinquishes all her rights of dower in and to
