 being the South East fourth of the North East fourth of Section
 Thirteen "13" of Township Seventy Six "76" of Range Twenty Nine "29"
 containing forty acres More or less To have and to hold said
 premises against with the appurtenances unto the said Alexander
 Wilson his heirs and assigns forever And the said Henry
 Wilson for himself and heirs doth hereby covenant with said
 Alexander Wilson his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully
 seized of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free and
 clear from all incumbrance whatever and that he will forever
 warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the
 said Alexander Wilson his heirs and assigns against the
 lawful claims of all persons whomsoever In testimony
 whereof the said Henry W. Wilson has hereunto set his hand
 and seal this 1st day of November in the year of our Lord
 One thousand eight hundred and fifty nine
