 for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand dollars
 paid by the said party of the second part. The Receipt of which is hereby
 acknowledged do by these, Grant, bargain, and sell unto the said
 party of the second part his heirs and assigns Two certain tracts or
 parcels of land situated in the County of Madison and State of Illinois
 known and described as follows to wit. The East half of the North West
 Quarter of Section Number Twenty One, 21, and the South West quarter
 of the North East Quarter, of Section Number Twenty One, 21, and all
 in Township Number Seventy five, 75. North in Range number
 Twenty six, 26, West. Together and with all and singular the heredit-
 aments and appurtenances, therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining
 to have and to hold the said premises as above described with
 the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs
 and assigns forever, And the said party of first part for herself and heirs
 executors and administrators doth hereby covenant to and with the said
 of the second part his heirs and assigns that he is well seized
 of the premises above conveyed as of a good and indefeasible estate
 in fee simple and hath good right to sell and convey the same
 in manner and form as aforesaid that the said premises are free
 from all incumbrances and that the above bargained premises
 in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said party of the second
 part his heirs and assigns, against the claim of all persons whom-
 soever he will forever warrant and defend.
