ship "74" Seventy four North of Range "29" Twenty nine
west of the 5th Principal Meridian Meridian containing
Eighty acres To have and to hold the said premises with
appurtenances unto the said Abraham Bartlett his heirs
and assigns forever and the said Edmund H. Meeker
for himself and his heirs doth hereby covenant with
said Abraham Bartlett his heirs and assigns that he is
lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid that the premises
are free and clear from all incumbrance whatsoever and
that he will forever warrant and defend the same with
the appurtenances unto the said Abraham Bartlett his heirs
and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons
